St. Peters Needy Association Report for February

Because of your generosity, the St. Peter's Needy Association - our parish outreach- is addressing the needs of approximately 75 persons each month. We continue to have small monthly fund balances. Because our February revenues and expenditures were not significantly different from the other monthly reports printed in our bulletin, February's report will summarize the basics of our parish outreach program as a review for our long term parishioners and as a news item for our new parishioners.

-Our Outreach Office (306-5243) is open Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 9AM to noon.

-Patricia Gould, Tom Gould and Janet Monaco staff the office--each taking one day a week.

-Our program works closely, often hand in hand, with Catholic Charities, St. Clements, other churches and the Department of Social Services.

-Our maximum annual aid per household is \$100. Exceptions are made in emergency situations. Our fund balance allows us to address these circumstances.

-Most of our assistance is given in the form of food and gas vouchers, and rent and utility bill assistance.
