Collection July 3 -4 for The Missions of Gonaives, Haiti

The second collection on July 3 - 4 will be for the Missions of Haiti. Haiti, the poorest country in our hemisphere, has a 65% illiteracy rate and 60% unemployment. 75% of the population lives in abject poverty, and the infant mortality rate is appallingly high—50% of children die before their fifth birthday. The Diocese of Gonaives serves more than one million Catholics. There are more than 200 small, native parishes, but only 48 priests. The Church is also the only place for children to receive education. It operates 18 feeding posts and 12 nutritional centers as well. Please be as generous as possible.
