### Update on Haiti

Father Joseph Philippe, a Haitian priest, will be visiting the Capital District to meet people who are interested in Haiti and to speak about conditions there six months after the earthquake.

In 1988 he started the Association of Peasants of Fondwa, working to overcome poverty and lack of government support for things we take for granted: water, sanitation, electricity, roads, schools and technical assistance for farmers. As a person of hope, Father Joseph will inspire you with this and his people's resilience after experiencing their work of the past 22 years reduced to rubble when the earth shifted for 35 second on January 12.
