In today's gospel a servant WAITED for the master to return. Waiting is a normal part of family life. We wait for a child's birth, then for small legs to catch up. Later we wait for teenagers to return home safely. Finally we wait alone anticipating a call or visit from an adult child. Waiting is sacred time, for even in the waiting we are connected.

Sure you talk a lot, but what about those awkward topics? Decide to be as honest and open with your spouse regarding even the most sensitive and uncomfortable issues. Difficult discussions usually don't go away if you wait; they just fester and come out fighting.

August 6 is the anniversary of the bombing of Hiroshima. Have we learned anything since then? "Not everyone is going to be a friend, but no one needs to be an enemy." (Raising Kids Who Will Make a Difference). How do you and your children deal with people you don't like? Avoid them? Pray for them? Try to understand them? Gossip about them? Confront them? Fight with them? Other?

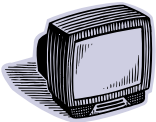
