We are in need of a Kindergarten catechist for our Sunday morning Religious Education Program. Materials and training are provided.

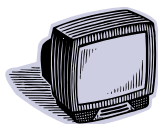
If you are able to help with this vital ministry to the children of our parish, please contact Rita Usher at 587-4487 for information.
